

CITY OF MESA LIBRARY FREE SPEECH ZONE

Soliciting support for a cause or signatures for a petition is permitted anywhere outside of a TEN FOOT BOUNDARY from the Public entrances or exits at each of the City of Mesa Library facilities. Patrons' access to or from the Library must not be impeded nor may patrons be forced into the parking lot in order to move around the Free Speech participants. Fund raising is strictly prohibited outside of the Libraries.

The Free Speech Zones are set up as a discretionary function of the City of Mesa Library System and may be discontinued at anytime without notice.

Any individual or group who is granted the use of a Free Speech Zone and conducts themselves in an unruly or disorderly manner will lose the privilege of continuing to locate within the Zone.

Guidelines for citizens:

1. The City of Mesa Library Free Speech Zones are available on a "first come, first served basis".
2. The City of Mesa Library Free Speech Zones are monitored and controlled by City of Mesa Security Officers or Library Staff.
3. No unattended signs are allowed and will be discarded.
4. Citizens may not attach any signage or other material to City property.
5. Fund raising is strictly prohibited outside of the City Libraries.
